**RE: BOIL WATER ADVISORY RESCINDED TO A PORTION OF THE BOISSEVAIN WATER SYSTEM**

Drinking Water Officer, Nnamdi Komlan-Dodoh has advised me that the Boissevain water system has met all conditions for rescinding the boil water advisory and that bacteriological testing results meet regulatory standards.

I am therefore rescinding the boil water advisory that was placed on a portion of the Boissevain water system [west of Highway 10, South of the railroad tracks] on July 2, 2025.

Please ensure all water users are notified that the advisory has been rescinded and that normal water usage can be resumed. A copy of this letter can be provided as notification. Notices posted in public locations are to be removed.
